

This report provides an analysis of food insecurity for 15 countries, focusing on crisis, emergency and famine situations. It describes the impact of conflict and gives an overview of the main drivers. (44 pp.) FAO & World Food Programme



**Special Report – FAO/WFP Crop and Food Security Assessment Mission to Sri Lanka**
