AGRICULTURE



Country Programming Framework for Ethiopia 2016–2020

Produced in partnership with the Government of Ethiopia, this publication sets out FAO's priorities in the country, namely: improving crop, fisheries and livestock production and commercialization, as well as the sustainable management of resources. (24 pp.)



Sustainable Land Management (SLM) in practice in the Kagera Basin: Lessons learned for scaling up at landscape level

This book identifies technologies (e.g. micro-dam irrigation, motor pumps) that decrease crop and livestock production risks. It shows how land restoration requires land users to understand the impacts of weather variability and climate change. (452 pp.)

This strategy includes an analysis of FAO's environmental performance and identifies ways to improve its ecological footprint and reduce its GHG emissions, such as implementing a circular economy strategy. (28 pp.)

Food import and export inspection and certification systems

In order to strengthen food control systems, this publication provides guidelines on different aspects of inspection and certification, including design and operation of systems, equivalence agreements, generic official certificates and product tracing. Forecasting threats to the food chain affecting food security in countries and regions

Given the potential impact of transboundary pests and diseases on food security, this issue provides country-level forecasts of threats for the coming three months, namely: fall armyworm, avian influenza, lumpy skin disease and African swine fever.
